### ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

- The finished artwork, including the frame, must be no larger than 90cm and no smaller than 30cm
- The artwork is not specific to a portrait only. Whole of body images are acceptable
- Medium can be water colour, acrylic or oil, photo-realism or a collage

**Finalists Artwork delivery:** Saturday 28th or Monday 30th November, 11am-2pm

**Awards Ceremony / Exhibition Opening:** Thursday 3rd December, 6pm-8pm

**Collection date:** Saturday 30th January 2021, or Monday 1st February, 10am-2pm

**Finalists:** The top 30-40 finalists will be chosen from a judging panel and notified by email by 24th November

**Winners:** The top 3 winners will be announced at the Exhibition opening on Thursday 3rd December 2020.

### REGISTRATION FEE

Main entry: \$25.00 (GST-free)

Refugee and people seeking Asylum \$10

### FINALISTS & PRIZES

- Top 40 finalists will be selected by a Judging Panel from the digital images submitted and will be notified by email by 24th November 2020
- The exhibition panel of judges will choose **three prize-winners** from the Top 40 finalists
- First prize is \$600, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize is \$350 and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize is \$250
- The list of finalists will be published on the website [www.space2b.com.au](http://www.space2b.com.au) in the Online Gallery by 30th November 2020. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into
- Artists who achieve selection in Top 40 finalists, must allow their work to be promoted online, on the Space2b website on Social Media and/or the future promotion of Space2b
- Those not selected as finalists, may also appear on the website in the Online Gallery.

### DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> and Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November 11am-2pm. Space2b will notify you of your assigned delivery time slot for delivery one week prior to delivery date.

#### Bring with You:

- A copy of your Registration form & confirmation email from Space2b (screenshot is fine)
- Your Eventbrite receipt
- Your completed, ready to hang Celebrity artwork as per T&C's

### PAYMENT OF SOLD WORK

Payment for all sales will be processed within 21 working days after end of exhibition.

### COLLECTION OF UNSOLD WORK

**DATE:** Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2021, 10am-2pm and Monday 1<sup>st</sup> February

#### Bring with You:

- Photo ID if artist is collecting
- If someone is collecting on your behalf they need to bring a permission note signed by you.

**Uncollected Artwork:** Please note we are unable to store work after the exhibition. Unless previous arrangements are made with Space2b management, any artwork left for longer than one week after the pickup date will be retained by Space2b as a donation to our programs and become the property of Space2b.

### ENTERING THE HEADS HIGH ART SHOW COMPETITION

- All registrations are to be made electronically via the online Registration form by **Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2020** together with a non-refundable administration fee of AUD\$25.00 (GST-free) paid via Humanitix. (Refugee and people seeking Asylum \$10). Please ensure your receipt number is included in the online Registration form. *Please note: Electronic submission is the only acceptable form of entry for The Heads High Art Show*
- An Artist statement (BIO) must be submitted with Registration form (no more than 200 words)
- A digital image of the finished artwork is to be received by **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2020** via email to [artspace@space2b.com.au](mailto:artspace@space2b.com.au)
- 25% commission on sales will be deducted by Space2b. For Refugee artworks, 35% will be deducted. Any art sales monies will be paid to the artist within 21 days after the exhibition ends
- The entered work must be new (completed within the previous 12 months) and must not have been shown previously or entered in any other competition
- Only one artwork per application will be accepted
- All artworks entered by the Artist must be the original work and concept of the Artist.

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Artist must sign the Agreement to the Terms and Conditions of Entry (T&C's) Heads High Art Show 2020.
- Insurance of art work is the responsibility of the Artist. Space2b will not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever caused to any work whilst in custody of space2b.
- Artists (and their Agents) who are selected as finalists must agree to not display any images of the selected work/s on Social Media platforms (Facebook, Instagram) **prior to** the announcement of the winner on **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2020** at the Exhibition Opening.
- All works selected for exhibition and exhibited, shall be for sale. The sale price indicated in the entry form shall apply and shall remain fixed for the duration of the exhibition.
