- The finished artwork, including the frame, must be no larger than 90cm and no smaller than 30cm
- The artwork is not specific to a theme.
- We will accept a wide range of 2D artworks of styles and mediums, including paintings, etchings, drawings, photography & limited edition prints.

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Saturday 26th or Sunday 27th November 2022 - from 3-5pm. Space2b will notify you of your assigned delivery time slot, for delivery one week prior to delivery date.

Bring with You:

- A copy of your Registration form & confirmation email from Space2b (screenshot is fine)
- Your completed, ready to hang artwork as per T&C's

PAYMENT OF SOLD WORK

Payment for all sales will be processed within 21 working days after end of exhibition.

COLLECTION OF UNSOLD WORK

DATE: Saturday 28th January 2023, 2-4pm

Bring with You:

- Photo ID if artist is collecting
- If someone is collecting on your behalf they need to bring a permission note signed by you.

Uncollected Artwork: Please note we are unable to store work after the exhibition. Unless previous arrangements are made with Space2b management, any artwork left for longer than one week after the pickup date will be retained by Space2b as a donation to our programs and become the property of Space2b.

ENTERING THE AFFORDABLE ART SHOW

- All registrations are to be made electronically via the online Registration form by **Sunday 13th November 2022** together with a non-refundable administration fee of AUD\$25.00 (GST-free) per artwork (max 2 pieces) paid via Paperform.
- An Artist statement (BIO) must be submitted with Registration form (no more than 200 words)
- 25% commission on sales will be deducted by Space2b. Any art sales monies will be paid to the artist within 21 days after the exhibition end
- The entered work must be new (completed within the previous 12 months) and must not have been shown previously or entered in any other exhibition
- Two artworks per application will be accepted
- All artworks entered by the Artist must be the original work and concept of the Artist.

- Artist must sign the Agreement to the Terms and Conditions of Entry (T&C's) Affordable Art Show 2022.

- All works for exhibition and exhibited, shall be for sale. The sale price indicated in the entry form shall apply and shall remain fixed for the duration of the exhibition.
